- Deepen your faith, your bible knowledge and your relationship with God
- Develop practical life and ministry skills
- Impact your community and beyond as you serve others
- Form lasting relationships with students and mentors
- Explore potential life direction

In choosing to come to FOUNDATIONS, you are accepting the challenge to live differently – even counter-culturally; to live in ways that love, honor and respect others in ways beyond our own personal needs and desires. Scripture outlines the kind of relationships God longs for us to have with one another: relationships that care for each other, seek the good of others before our own, giving up our rights, serving one another, and growing together in unity in Christ in the midst of our inevitable diversities. This is the heart and foundation upon which the following guidelines and principles are grounded. Living in healthy community is not easy, but it is worth the effort.

FOUNDATIONS is committed to nurturing an atmosphere of growth, love and mutual respect. We firmly believe that learning and growth at FOUNDATIONS involves much more than just attending courses, but rather encompasses every aspect of one's life – intellectual, emotional, social, and spiritual, which is not only helpful for this season, but will also shape and prepare you for life, work, ministry and relationships for the rest of your life.

The following outlines how you can commit to growing and fostering a healthy, God-centered community at the school:

I will actively seek to nurture my spiritual development by devoting time to my relationship with Jesus Christ through the exercise of spiritual disciplines.

I will foster my involvement in the community and worship of God by participating in chapel, and all school events.

I will seek to develop my experience practically by participating in a ministry elective.

I will engage in the honest pursuit of knowledge exercising careful judgment in the use of my time, energy and material resources.

I will make a commitment to maintain the biblical design for purity in matters of human sexuality.

I will pursue a life that is guided by biblical practices (i.e. honesty, love, integrity, grace) and refrain from any practices (e.g. lying, gossip, profanity, etc.) that the bible condemns.

I agree to abstaining from the use of alcohol, tobacco or recreational drugs while participating in the school.

I agree to not engage in harassment of any kind. (sexual, verbal, physical, mental or online bullying)

I commit to following the leadership of FOUNDATIONS, Creekside Church and their policies while attending the school.
